- 1. Contestants must pre-register (<u>www.BCcommunitycenter.org</u>) no walk-ups will be accepted for contest judgment.
- 2. Contestants must sign-in at the front desk upon arrival and then pay your entry fee of \$20.00
- 3. All food must be prepared in advance and ready to serve when judging begins
- 4. Tables and power outlets will be provided for each contestant and all items must fit on one table (6ft)
- 5. Contestants should prepare between 3-5 quarts of chili.
- 6. All ingredients are OK to use, no restrictions. If you are using ingredients people may be allergic to, please let a staff member know so OK can make signs to be posted at your station.
- 7. Eating utensils such as: bowls, spoons are provided by the contestant.
- 8. Each chef will be able to prepare the chili cup serving for judging. Runners will receive the cup and serve it to the judges.
- 9. Contestants are responsible for the clean-up of their station. This should be done promptly to ensure we have time for each division. Wipes will be provided at each table.
- 10. Event staff will dispose of left-over items after the close of the event
